**THE QUALIFIER WILL BE 36 HOLES IN ONE DAY.**

All contestants are responsible for arriving for their tee time at the assigned tee. NO EXCEPTIONS will be considered. Players are encouraged to call the golf course to schedule a practice round. Practice rounds are NOT included in the entry or green fees. Practice rounds can be scheduled by calling 419 797 9813, \$40.00 per round including cart.

Hotel arrangements can be made by calling Catawba Island Club Hotel at 419 797 4424, space is limited.

**To CANCEL** your scheduled entry in the tournament or questions, **call** Terry Seagert at **(419) 626 – 5738; cell (419) 271-4084.**

**Upon arrival: CHECK IN** and **pay the \$ 40.00 GREEN FEES** to the cashier. Fees include Driving Range Use. The Driving Range opens at 6:30 AM.

The field will play 18 holes beginning at 7:30 AM followed by ½ Hour for lunch and then 18 holes in the early afternoon. The Qualifier and Alternates will be determined by lowest Medal Score and, possibly a Playoff. The 1 qualifier will advance to the 87<sup>th</sup> U.S. Amateur Public Links Championship July 9 - 14 at **Soldier Hollow Golf Club**, Midway, UT.

The “One Ball Rule” is in effect for this tournament. This means you must play the same brand and model ball throughout your stipulated round. Make sure your equipment is on the current “Conforming Equipment/Ball” list found on the Internet at [www.usga.org](http://www.usga.org).

Distance Measuring Devices (RANGEFINDERS) are **NOT** permitted in competition.

Players must WALK at all times for a stipulated round. Pull carts are allowed. Carts will be available under the Americans With Disabilities Act **ONLY by following instructions that can be found at [www.usga.org/champs/ADA](http://www.usga.org/champs/ADA).**

Spectators are permitted to WALK the course (rough only NOT on fairways). They are **NOT** permitted to use golf carts. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Tee Times are included in this mailing (may be subject to change).
